REQUIREMENTS TO MAINTAIN AN ACTIVE FLORAL DESIGN JUDGE'S CERTIFICATE

To maintain an <u>Active</u> Floral Design Judge's Certificate a Judge must abide by the requirements stipulated by B.C. Council of Garden Clubs which are listed below and may be revised when necessary. A form provided by BC Council of Garden Clubs must be submitted annually.

- 1. A Floral Design Judge must submit a form annually to B.C. Council of Garden Clubs to provide proof:
 - a. They must belong to and be a participating member of one of the following Judges' Associations and/or Floral Design Clubs; currently:
 - i. The Okanagan Floral Art and Horticulture Judge's Association.
 - ii. The Society of Horticultural and Floral Design Judges of B.C.
 - iii. The Vancouver Island Horticulture Judges' Group.
 - iv. B.C. Floral Art Society.
 - v. Capilano Flower Arranging Club.
 - vi. Chilliwack Floral Art Club.
 - vii. Mid Island Floral Art Club.
 - viii. Okanagan Floral Art Club.
 - ix. Victoria Floral Artists' Guild.
- 2. In order to keep up to date a Floral Design Judge must continue to enter exhibits in shows, attend workshops or symposiums or be a presenter of demonstrations. Please note that judging a show is not a requirement and does not fulfill any of the options below.
 - a. Provide proof of entry of a minimum of one (1) Floral Design exhibit in each of two (2) judged shows annually.

b. Provide proof of participating in two (2) workshops/symposiums for Floral Design Judges annually.

Or

c. Provide proof of being a presenter of two (2) demonstrations/speaking engagements in Floral Design annually.

<u>Or</u>

- d. Provide proof of an annual combination of:
 - (1) Floral Design exhibit and (1) workshop/symposium for Floral Design Judges.
 - Or (1) workshop/symposium for Floral Design Judges and (1) presentation/speaking engagement in Floral Design.
 - Or (1) Floral Design exhibit and (1) presentation/speaking engagement in Floral Design.
- 3. A Floral Design Judge must allow their contact information to be put on the B.C. Council of Garden Clubs web site.
