## **Floral Design Courses**

## **Policies and Procedures**

- 1. Must be taught by an Active BCCGC Qualified Floral Design Judge that has been taught how to teach the applicable level.
- 2. Taught by qualified volunteers; Two wherever possible
- 3. Participants must register in advance for the course.
- 4. The course fee includes:
  - a. Venue
  - b. Instructors demonstration Plant Material
  - c. Supplies
  - d. Instructors' travel expenses and /or mileage
  - e. Other expenses
  - f. Workbook (when applicable)
- 5. Participants pay the entire course fee and expenses in advance of the course or, with prior approval of the organizer, at the first class.
- 6. No refunds.
- 7. Participants may miss only one class, and all efforts must be made to make and submit the missed design(s).
- 8. Participants can make up a missed class by emailing a picture of the required design they have made themselves to the instructor or by bringing the design to the next class.
- 9. Alternatively, participants can make up a missed class at a future course offered.
- 10. All designs submitted must be the participants own original work.
- 11. Instructors will take attendance of participants at all classes ensuring the required designs have been done.
- 12. Participants will receive a Certificate from BCCGC 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President if they complete the course and required designs. Participants' names and date of course will be recorded on the master list with the BCCGC 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President.
- 13. Participants are to take courses in order, Levels 1 through 6. Previous courses are prerequisites.
- 14. All 6 Levels are pre-requisites to becoming a Floral Design Judge.
